



RELEASE AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY FOR ADOPT-A-STREET PARTICIPANTS

Safety Considerations

Thank you for taking part in the Auraria Campus Adopt-a-Street program! The ASCP continually strives to increase the campus waste diversion rate and reduce the amount of waste sent to landfills. This program allows our students to directly take part in these efforts. When participating, please keep the following **safety considerations** in mind and sign your initials on the line after reading each item:

- Always take note of the weather forecast and plan accordingly. Water, sunscreen, proper clothing, and intermittent breaks are suggested in all weather conditions. _____
- Individuals may come across sharp objects such as needles, broken glass, broken aluminum, and more. **Do not collect these objects.** Please contact ASCP, ACPD, or Auraria Health Center if your team comes across these objects. Take note of the location using pictures, buildings, and streets. _____
- The ASCP will provide grabbers, trash bags, and gloves. Additional protective equipment must be requested in advance. _____
- All waste collected will go into landfill dumpsters. Be sure that the collected waste goes into the correct disposal bin. This means that **no waste** will be deposited into the recycling or compost. The nearest dumpster to the Tivoli garage is at the north Tivoli dock. _____
- Always be aware of traffic before going onto or crossing the roads. The only time to be in the roads is to collect waste. We recommend having a lookout buddy when it is necessary to collect waste directly from the road. _____

Liability Waiver

I want to volunteer my services to the Auraria Sustainable Campus Program (ASCP), and the Auraria Higher Education (AHEC). I certify that I am in good mental and physical condition, and I understand the inherent risks associated with acting as a volunteer including the risk of physical injury. hazardous, and I waive all liability for injuries that may result from the negligence or carelessness of fellow volunteers, myself, or the public.

I understand that the ASCP/ AHEC shall not be responsible for loss or theft of personal property, or damage to personal property. I understand that my participation as a volunteer in this activity is purely and solely voluntary and that I am not an employee, contractor, or representative of the ASCP.

I hereby acknowledge that I have carefully read this Release and Waiver of Liability for Volunteers, that I fully understand its contents, that I am over the age of 18, and that I am signing this Release and Waiver of Liability for Volunteers voluntarily and intend for it to be legally binding for this volunteer event, and all those in the future I choose to participate in.
