Adopt-A-Street Rules and Guidelines

Hello! Thank you for choosing to be a part of the Adopt-A-Street program and dedicating your organization's time to beautifying our campus. Below is a rundown of the process of participating in the program, as well as safety rules and regulations that **MUST** be followed. This information can also be found in our instructional video on the website.

Guidelines:

- Your team will earn the plaque by dedicating two periods each month to collecting litter
 and waste around the area you've signed up for. When you successfully complete two
 semesters of monthly logged collection, your organization will be eligible for an Adopt-aStreet recognition!
- Your organization will choose a road to sponsor and organize periods for collection each month. Your organization is responsible for coordinating all communication within your team. This includes the who, what, when, and where. All materials for waste collection will be provided by the ASCP. After you and your team have agreed on the who, what, when, and where you will sign out waste collection materials from the Tivoli garage and log your time when you return. In addition, you will have the chance to weigh your collected waste and directly measure the impact you are making!

Rules:

- Always take note of the weather forecast and plan accordingly. Water, sunscreen, proper clothing, and intermittent breaks are suggested in all weather conditions.
- Individuals may come across sharp objects such as needles, broken glass, broken aluminum, and more. Do not collect these objects. Please contact ASCP, ACPD, or Auraria Health Center
- In dealing with garbage, there is a risk of hazardous waste. If it looks like it has gone
 into, or come out of a body, do not touch it! Notify ASCP, ACPD, or the Auraria Health
 Center
- The ASCP will provide grabbers, trash bags, and gloves. Additional protective
 equipment must be requested in advance. These will be in a locked public box for you to
 access prior to your event. It is the leader's responsibility to ensure that these items are
 not harmed during use and that they are returned to their storage location at the end of
 the event.
- All waste collected will go into landfill dumpsters. Be sure that the collected waste goes
 into the correct disposal bin. This means that no waste will be deposited into the
 recycling or compost. The nearest dumpster to the Tivoli garage is at the north Tivoli
 dock.
- Always have extra awareness of traffic before going onto or crossing the roads. Do not spend an extended amount of time on the roads. We recommend having a partner to keep a lookout if there is waste in the roads that needs to be collected.
- Have fun and know that you are making a difference!
