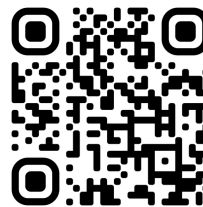
The mission of the Green Office Program is to increase all staff, faculty, and administrator knowledge about behavioral changes that will contribute to the overall sustainability practices of the office or department.
