JOB SUMMARY:

This position is responsible for supporting the Auraria Sustainable Campus Program (ASCP) through marketing, outreach, and general program support in order to expand the reach of the ASCP and increase awareness of sustainability initiatives on campus. The selected candidate will work as part of a 4–5-person marketing team to grow our social media following, newsletter subscribers, website traffic, brand recognition, and campus engagement with the ASCP. This specific position will oversee content and engagement on our ASCP social media accounts, generate graphics for social media, take photo and video content, and work to improve our engagement with the campus community. The following skills/attributes are desired: knowledge of/passion for sustainability, proficiency in (and passion for) social media marketing and engagement, graphic design experience, the ability to adapt to changing priorities, and a positive attitude. The ideal candidate will work well with others but also has the ability to work effectively with little direction. This person will report directly to the ASCP Graduate Assistant. We are looking for a one-year commitment with the possibility of continued employment.
