  - Bill went through capital and was approved, will then go to the senate.
  - This would grant voting power to FACAB and SACAB representatives.
- Tivoli Re-Imagined - ASCPAC Participation
  - Opportunity to incorporate sustainability initiatives into the Tivoli Re-Imagined project.
    - Committee can review initial construction renderings and brainstorm ideas for projects related to water, energy, transportation etc.
    - The project will include a community hub and we could explore an environmental justice focus.
- Minutes - Grammatical revisions, suggestions and phrasing
