

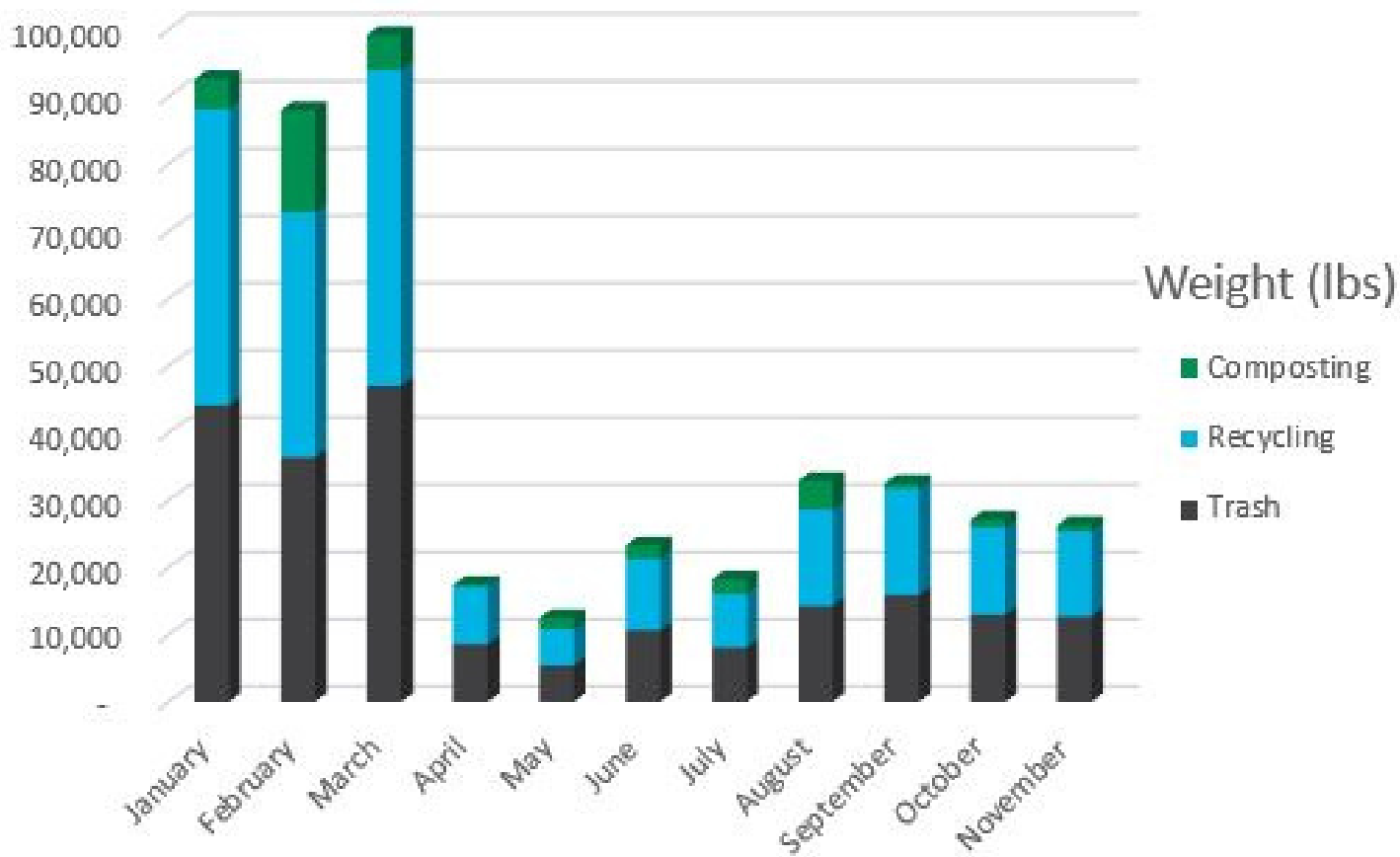

14,611 lbs of coal being burned

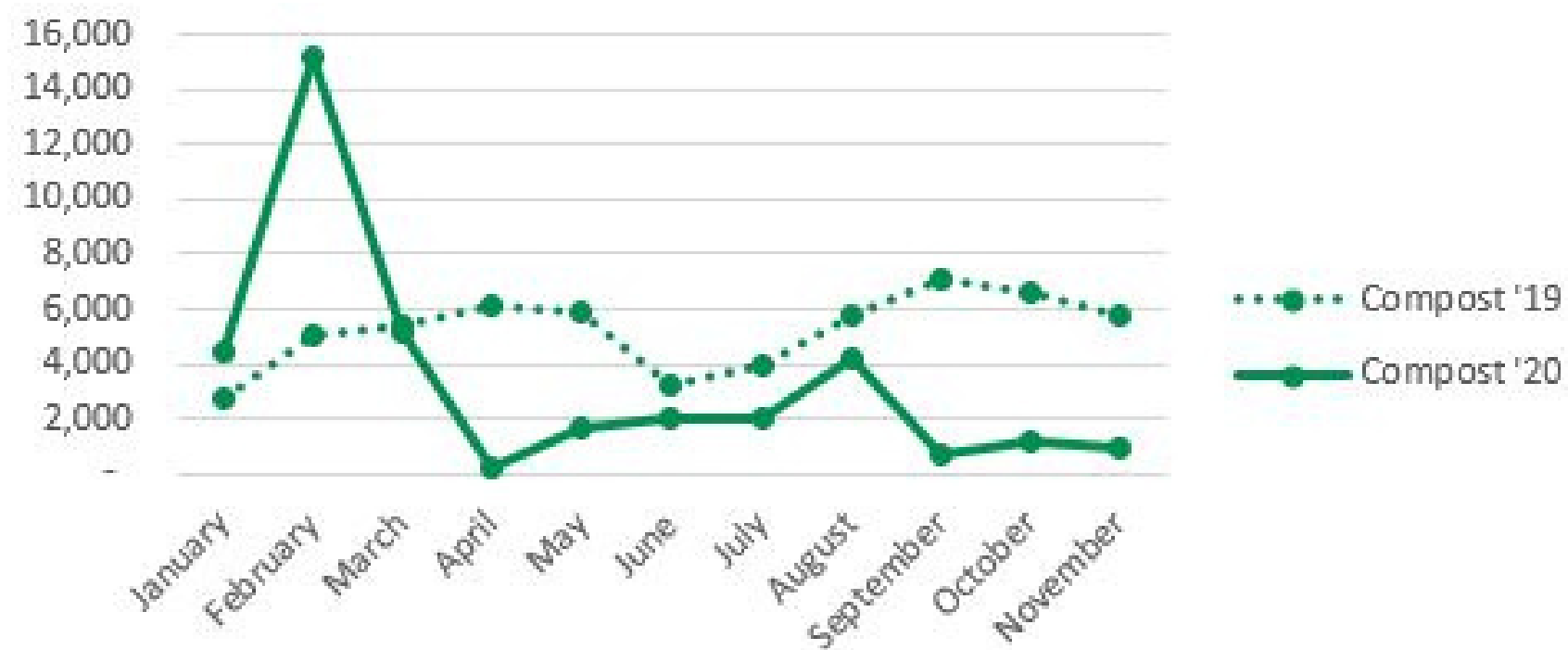


0.09 acres of forest sequestering carbon

The **Compost Weight** collected at the Auraria Campus in November was **909 lbs**. That is a **84.14%** decrease compared to this month last year.
