- Evangelina Updates
 - Met with City Heights community representative to discuss a potential collaboration with ASCPAC or SACAB on feminine products/other hygiene products. Exploring support for other resources such as healthcare, emergency housing, etc.

 - There will be a separate survey for students and faculty
 - The survey will contain a sustainability section
 - **Action items:**
 - Clarify goal of the survey (bridge gaps across three Auraria institutions, etc.)

- Determine who hosts survey (SACAB, AHEC?) and next steps
- Administer the survey in January 2026
