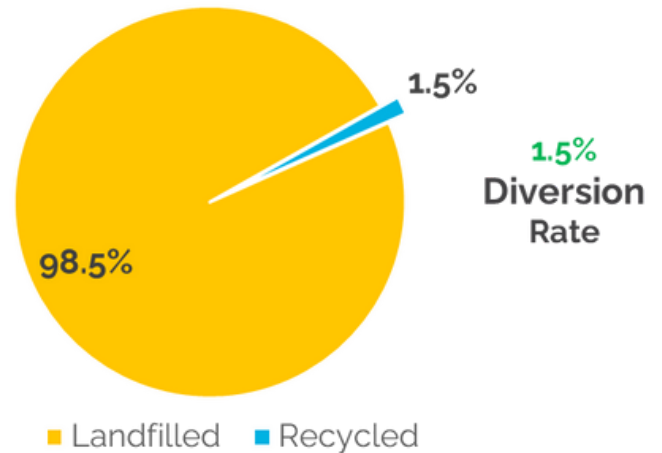


This month we had:

A1 Organics Press Release

Effective April 1, 2023, accepted materials in residential and commercial compost collection will be limited to:

- ONLY food scraps
- ONLY yard / plant trimmings
- ONLY 3 gallon certified (CMA Approved) compostable bags used to collect food scraps
